The **Western Child and Adolescent Hospital**, under the Western Regional Health Authority (a Statutory Body under the Ministry of Health & Wellness) is currently seeking to employ two (2) **Artisan 3 - Electrician (LMO/TS 4)**. Reporting to the Senior Electrician, the incumbent is responsible for carrying out electrical maintenance and repairs such as the installation and replacement of lights, conduits; signage, and other fixtures and fittings.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Installation of electrical fixtures such as conduit, junction boxes, wiring, switches, lights (bulbs) and circuit breakers
- Repair of electrical fixtures and fittings such as electrical wiring and lights
- Inspection, investigation, and solving conditions for unusual odours caused by electrical issues
- Inspection of equipment grounding components such as conductors and connections
- Tightening of electrical connections including outlets, breakers, and panels
- Verifying of grounding of the equipment and associated neutral where applicable
- Identifying and reporting major electrical problems to the Manager, Maintenance in writing
- Removal and re-installment of light fixtures, transformers, motor controllers, relays and ballasts and fluorescent fixtures
- Maintenance of items such as pole-mounted lights, emergency generators, radio/communication and public address/recording systems, uninterrupted power supplies and other electrical systems and equipment
- Performs other related duties that may be assigned by the Senior Electrician and or the Manager, Maintenance

SPECIAL CONDITIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE JOB:

- May be required to work beyond normal working hours, weekends and public holidays from time to time
- Work is performed in an indoor and outdoor field environment; may be exposed to noise, dust, grease, fumes, noxious odours, and gases, mechanical and electrical hazards
- Ability to stand, sit, bend, stoop, walk or crawl as necessary to supervise and perform maintenance and repairs
- Possess manual dexterity and finger coordination to grasp, hold, turn or squeeze objects, tools and equipment

- Possess a sense of vision and hearing at a necessary level to diagnose problems, use tools, and implement preventative or corrective solutions
- Work may be performed in confined areas such as those between ceilings and roofs; may include exposure to electrical shock and airborne particles
